We handed out 495 stationary packs. We blessed 335 children with school shoes. We handed out 800 blankets to our children and 225 to our elderly folk. We clothed 509 children and 225 elderly folks in warm jerseys and winter socks. We saw 75 new registrations for participation in our Mahala Shop initiative (our community upliftment project). Our vegetable garden grew bigger and better. We distributed more than 5000 food parcels year to date. All this was possible because you started a tradition of giving back to other less fortunate than you. Your love and kindness followed them throughout this year. We can't always express our innermost appreciation as often as we want to, therefore we want to use this opportunity to tell you how much we appreciate all you do for us. Your love for our cause leaves a tradition with a future. You give our children and elderly folk hope...
